EDITORIAL

The first issue of our scientific journal in 2024 is content-oriented on two areas of problems. The first pair of contributions focuses on selected aspects of two important population groups of every democratic state – women and seniors. The author of the introductory article (Halász) offers the reader the history of the gradual advancement of women in government positions in the Central European countries. The pair of authors (Kamrádová – Václavíková) devotes attention to solving problems related to the position of seniors in a democratic state in general and in the conditions of the Czech Republic in particular.

The second pair of contributions focuses on selected problems of municipal self-government, coincidentally in the Slovak Republic. The first of them (Švikruha – Bardovič) analyzes the problem of small municipalities, which represent one of the neurological points of Slovak municipal self-government. The authors discuss existing problems (according to their own vision) in this area and look for ways to solve them. The final contribution (Korn) of this issue takes note of selected political-legal aspects of the election (but to a certain extent also of the functioning) of the chief controller of the municipality in general and from the point of view of a specific city in particular.
